The total contributions based on this formula, which again, is beyond your normal tithes and offerings is only \$350.00 if you are a single person or if you are a husband and wife, \$500.00. Additionally, this plan of giving will offer over \$35,000.00 per year, above our tithes and offerings, based upon the commitment of 100 members of the Southern Star Family. If we pull together, not waiting for someone else to "do it", we will be able to complete many projects that are needed at our church. We can do this in Jesus' name, not just the present, but for years to come.

Again, I wish to continue teaching our congregation and friends about the importance of being blessed from a financial perspective. God has a method of blessing us financially and we have to fulfill our portion of the plan. When the scriptures speak about giving it is not because it is some "get-rich-quick" scheme, but a method of being financially blessed for the rest of your life through the "windows of heaven." Learn to reduce the financial pressures and anxieties in your life by realizing that God's first plan of action in being blessed financially is the tithe. We experienced a serious attempt of the financial plan on "All Tithes Sunday." If you are in the position to continuing the program, please do not stop. The Star Café - Recipe of the Month

Gluten Free Skillet Chicken Divan Ingredients

- 1 tablespoon butter or margarine
- 4 boneless skinless chicken breasts (about 1 lb.)
- Water called for on brown rice package for 1 cup uncooked rice
- 2 tablespoons Dijon mustard
- 1/4 teaspoon salt

- 1/8 teaspoon pepper
- 1 cup uncooked quick-cooking brown rice
- 3 cups Green Giant® Valley Fresh Steamers™ frozen broccoli florets, thawed
- 1/2 cup shredded Cheddar or American cheese (2 oz)

Directions

- 1. Melt butter in 10-inch nonstick skillet over medium-high heat. Add chicken; cook 1 to 2 minutes on each side or until browned.
- 2. Remove chicken from skillet. Add water, mustard, salt and pepper to skillet; stirring with wire whisk until blended. Heat to boiling. Stir in rice; return to boiling. Place chicken pieces and broccoli over rice. Reduce heat to low; cover and simmer about 10 minutes or until most of liquid is absorbed and juice of chicken is clear when center of thickest part is cut (170°F).
- 3. Sprinkle with cheese; cover and let stand 5 minutes.



So the little boy did.


The third time he came back the salesman was ashamed and started to lecture the boy.

To expand your wings and fly






Arise in your God-given gifts For this is your finest hour Arise in the Lord's holy might, Ignited and empowered






