This month of April marks the celebration of Evangelism Month at the Southern Star Missionary Baptist Church. This month marks the physical observance of the Great Commission, which for contemporary Christians, is one of the most significant passages in the Holy Bible. First, it's the last recorded personal instruction given by Jesus to His disciples. Second, it's a special calling from Jesus Christ to all His followers to take specific action while on this earth. The Great Commission: And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen. (Matthew 28:18-20) The Great Commission is the end of a Gospel and the beginning of faith in action for all Christians. This command from Jesus is significant because it's a personal instruction for Christians to have a profound faith in Jesus Christ as indicated in verse 18. "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth." This is an incredibly powerful statement which demands faith in Jesus Christ, validating His power in the lives of Christians and their commitment to Him. This verse acts as a clear claim to Christ's omnipotence, and therefore His deity. If Christians do not believe this statement, complete faith does not exist. Jesus is very clear about His authority in the world -- it is complete and total from the beginning of time itself (John 1:1-3). It is our goal that each family will be responsible for the recruitment of one family to the Southern Star Missionary Baptist Church during the month of April. Although evangelism occurs each day, and several members are dedicated to the glorious work that this task affords, we wish to make a special emphasis of allowing this month to be a celebration of all our evangelism efforts.

I wish to thank our membership for your contributions as we celebrated a successful Women's History Month. I thank God for Reverend Angela French-Coles for the powerful message of the day! This month's calendar has a schedule of events and services that are planned to honor God and our church family. In addition, as we prepare for our Church Anniversary, which is the second of our four annual days, we wish to prepare ourselves for the next financial goal. Our financial goal for the Church Anniversary, which will be celebrated on the third Sunday in May, is that we are asking each nuclear family to contribute \$100.00 beyond their normal tithes and offerings. Remember, you may make your contributions partially or in total each Sunday through your offering envelope. I will have additional information concerning this effort in upcoming missives. God will bless you in your efforts!

As we are saving funds for the next phase of our remodeling, remember to begin planning for the gifts for the Church Anniversary. Remember, you may make your contributions partially or in total each Sunday through your offering envelope. God will bless you in your efforts. Listed below is that yearly Plan of Giving that will occur on each of the four Annual Days. Again, our gifts will follow this format:

The total contributions based on this formula, which again, is beyond your normal tithes and offerings is only \$350.00 if you are a single person or if you are a husband and wife, \$600.00. Additionally, this plan of giving will offer over \$35,000.00 per year, above our tithes and offerings, based upon the commitment of 100 members of the Southern Star Family. If we pull together, not waiting for someone else to "do it", we will be able to complete many projects that are needed at our church. We can do this in Jesus' name, not just the present, but for years to come.

God has a method of blessing us financially and we must fulfill our portion of the plan. When the scriptures speak about giving it is not because it is some "get-rich-quick" scheme, but a method of being financially blessed for the rest of your life through the "windows of heaven." Remember, to be successful in this you must <u>Plan</u> for it, <u>Practice</u> it, and <u>Pray</u> for it, and it will happen for you <u>permanently</u>. Continue to keep the church and her members in your daily prayers. We must never forget that "God is good all the time and all the time, God is good!" The Star Café - Recipe of the Month

Every month we will feature a recipe. If you have a recipe or two that you would like to share and want to feature in the SSMBC "The Star Journal", please submit it through email at southernstar@southernstarbapt.org or submit it to Sis. Vera Mitchell. This month's recipe is:

Banana Pudding

Ingredients

- 3 cups milk
- 2 vanilla beans, split lengthwise
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 2 tablespoons plus 1 teaspoon cornstarch
- Pinch of salt
- 6 large egg yolks

- 2 tablespoons unsalted butter, cut up
- 12 ounces vanilla wafers
- 5 ripe bananas, peeled and cut into 1/4-inch thick rounds
- 1 cup heavy cream
- 2 tablespoons confectioner's sugar

Directions:

Bring the milk and vanilla beans to a simmer in a medium saucepan over low heat. Using tongs, remove the beans from the milk. Using the tip of a small sharp knife, scrape the tiny seeds from each bean back into the milk.

Whisk the sugar, cornstarch and salt in a medium bowl. Add the egg yolks and whisk well. Gradually whisk in about half of the hot milk, then pour the yolk mixture into the saucepan. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly, until the pudding comes to a full boil. Remove from the heat and whisk in the butter until melted. Transfer to a medium bowl. Cover the pudding with a piece of plastic wrap pressed directly onto the surface and pierce a few holes in the wrap with the tip of a knife. Let stand until tepid, about 30 minutes.

Spoon about 1 cup of the pudding into a 2- to 2 1/2-quart glass bowl. Layer the cookies, bananas and pudding in the bowl, ending with the pudding. Cover tightly and refrigerate until chilled, at least 4 hours or overnight.

Whip the cream and confectioners' sugar in a chilled medium bowl until stiff. Spread the whipped cream over the pudding. Serve chilled, spooned into bowls. Serves 8.

"Preparing for the Encounter"
Matthew 26:36-46

After the Last Supper, Jesus and His disciples went to Gethsemane. Once among the trees, Jesus told them to sit down, but He took Peter, James, and John a little farther to a place where they could pray.

Suddenly Jesus began to give way to His grief and distress of heart, telling His friends that His sadness was almost overwhelming. Asking them to wait where they were, He went farther into the grove and fell on His face in prayer. It was a plea of two parts: to be delivered from what He must endure and for God's will to be done.

After praying for some time, Jesus arose and returned to His disciples finding them sound asleep. He was disappointed that Peter had not been able to stay awake. Together, We Can ...

EASTER STORY COOKIES

To be made the evening before Easter. Preheat oven to 300° (this is important-don't wait until you're half done with the recipe). You need:

1c. whole pecans

1 tsp. vinegar

3 egg whites zipper baggie

wooden spoon

pinch salt

1c. sugar tape

Bible



Place pecans in zipper baggie and let children beat them with the wooden spoon to break into small pieces. Explain that after Jesus was arrested, He was beaten by the Roman soldiers.

Read John 19:1-3

Let each child smell the vinegar. Put 1 tsp. vinegar into mixing bowl. Explain that when Jesus was thirsty on the cross, he was given vinegar to drink.

Read John 19:28-30

Add egg whites to vinegar. Eggs represent life. Explain that Jesus gave His life to give us life.

Read John 10:10 -11

Sprinkle a little salt into each child's hand. Let them taste it and brush the rest into the bowl. Explain that this represents the salty tears shed by Jesus' followers, and the bitterness of our own sin.

Read Luke 23:27

So far, the ingredients are not very appetizing. Add 1c. sugar. Explain that the sweetest part of the story is that Jesus died because He loves us. He wants us to know and belong to Him.

Read Psalm 34:8 and John 3:16

Beat with a mixer on high speed for 12 to 15 minutes until stiff peaks are formed. Explain that the color white represents the purity in God's eyes of those whose sins have been cleansed by Jesus.

Read Isaiah1:18 and John 3:1-3

Fold in broken nuts. Drop by teaspoons onto wax paper covered cookie sheet. Explain that each mound represents the rocky tomb here Jesus' body was laid.

Read Matthew 27:57-60

Put the cookie sheet in the oven, close the door and turn the oven OFF. Give each child a piece of tape and seal the oven door. Explain that Jesus' tomb was sealed.

Read Matthew 27:65-66

GO TO BED! Explain that they may feel sad to leave the cookies in the oven overnight. Jesus' followers were in despair when the tomb was sealed.

Read John 16:20 and 22


On Easter morning, open the oven and give everyone a cookie. Notice the cracked surface and take a bite. The cookies are hollow! On the first Easter Jesus' followers were amazed to find the tomb open and empty.
