This month of May marks the celebration of the 63rd Anniversary of the Southern Star Missionary Baptist Church. Our anniversary will be celebrated on the 3rd Sunday. The theme of the celebration is *"Silver and Gold have I none, but what I give to you…" - Acts 3:6.* Our special guests for our 3:30 PM Worship Service will be the Reverend William G. Nelson and the Greater St. Mark Baptist Church. Dinner will be served following the morning worship service. As a church, we continue to make great strides while traveling through this earthly journey, as we strive towards the impending coming of the Kingdom. Another year that God has provided continues to bring life, love, and spiritual closeness to Him that is able. Additionally, Vacation Bible School will be held June 10th thru June 14th.

I wish to honor all mothers and women who have served in that capacity in some manner or another. We have come this far by faith and on many occasions, it was a mother, grandmother, or "motherly figure" who strived for our best interests. I am grateful to God that I was blessed to have the experiences a strong and forceful example in my life. Although my momma' is in heaven, I wish to bless the women, especially in Southern Star, who continue to shower me with matriarchal love and care. On this day, Mothers of Southern Star, we salute you!

This month also serves as a witness to the power of faith and the blessings of God because of our faith. Recall, the initial verse of this chapter, Hebrews 11:1, is that "Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen" (NKJV). We celebrate this day because we exercised our faith and "Stood on His Promises." By faith we see and understand where God has brought us from. Now as we celebrate this anniversary, we also celebrate the strength of our faith and our dependence on the Lord.

This month's calendar has a schedule of events and services that are planned to honor God and our church family. As we prepare for our Church Anniversary, which is the second of our four annual days, we wish to prepare ourselves for the financial goal of the event. We are asking each nuclear family to contribute \$100.00 beyond their normal tithes and offerings. Remember, you may make your contributions partially or in total each Sunday through your offering envelope. I will have additional information concerning this effort in upcoming missives. God will bless you in your efforts!

I am encouraging all to give the amounts requested for the Church Anniversary. Listed below is our Plan of Giving that will occur on each of the four Annual Days. Again, our gifts will follow this format:

The total contributions based on this formula, which again, is beyond your normal tithes and offerings is only 350 if you are a single person or if you are a husband and wife, 600. Additionally, this plan of giving will offer 35,000 + per year, above our tithes and offerings, based upon the commitment of 100 members of the Southern Star Family. If we pull together, not waiting for someone else to "do it", we will be able to complete many projects that are needed at our church. We can do this in Jesus' name, not just the present, but for years to come.

Again, I wish to continue teaching our congregation and friends about the importance of being blessed from a financial perspective. God has a method of blessing us financially and we must fulfill our portion of the plan. When the scripture speaks about giving it is not because it is some "get-rich-quick" scheme, but a method of being financially blessed for the rest of your life through the "windows of heaven." Learn to reduce the financial pressures and anxieties in your life by realizing that God's first plan of action in being blessed financially is the Tithe. We experienced a serious attempt of the financial plan on "All Tithes Sunday." If you are in the process of working on your commitment, do not stop in your efforts to get it together. Remember, to be successful in this you must <u>Plan</u> for it, <u>Practice</u> it, and <u>Pray</u> for it, and it will happen for you <u>permanently</u>. Continue to keep the church and her members in your daily prayers. We know that God hears and answers prayers. We must never forget that "God is good all the time and all the time, God is good!" Because of the faith let us be willing to follow the vision of God. For <u>such a time as this</u>, we have been chosen as instruments of God's plan for the procurement and elevation of this church and community. I ask that you join me as we move into <u>such a time as this</u> at the Southern Star Missionary Baptist Church.

The Star Café - Recipe of the Month

Peach Crisp

Ingredients						
 5 pounds peaches (about 12), each cut into 8 wedges 1/3 cup granulated sugar ³/₄ cup plus 1 tablespoon all-purpose flour 1 ¹/₄ cups light brown sugar 	 ¹/₄ teaspoon kosher salt ³/₄ cup (1 ¹/₂ sticks) unsalted butter, chilled and cut into small pieces 2 cups rolled oats 1 cup almonds, roughly chopped 					

Directions

- 1. Heat oven to 350° F. In a large bowl, toss the peaches, granulated sugar, and 1 tablespoon of the flour. Transfer to a shallow 3-quart baking dish.
- 2. In a separate bowl, combine the brown sugar, salt, and the remaining ³/₄ cup of flour. Using your fingers, incorporate the butter until coarse crumbs form. Mix in the oats and almonds.
- 3. Squeeze the topping into marble-size clumps and sprinkle on the peaches. Bake until the top is golden and the fruit is tender, 45 to 55 minutes.

The Responsible Tither tithes <u>regularly</u>. If a Responsible Tither is absent, he/she ensures that any missed tithes are submitted upon return.


Irresponsible Tithers

The Irresponsible Tither is convinced that he/she is a tither, but only pays tithes <u>occasionally</u>. For example, the Irresponsible Annual Tithe figures above are based on a member that tithes weekly and only attended church 30 out of 52 weeks. This member did <u>not</u> submit any missed tithes that occurred during their absence.

Members who gave \$300.00 for the year, regardless of Sundays attended. Average gift \$5.77 per 52 Sundays.


