Mark 10:46-52

Often times when we are confronted with difficult decisions or are going through some type of conflict, it becomes so easy to just give up and throw in the towel. We try something else and that fails, too. The next thing we know, we are in a state of hopelessness or helplessness. I can mention the successes of two prominent Black men who attest to the fact that persistence pays: Tyler Perry and Steve Harvey.

In our featured scripture for this article, we have the story of Bartimaeus, a blind beggar who lived in Jericho. Bartimaeus had become sick and tired of his plight of being blind and having to beg to survive.


## Prayer for Our Pastor
