Remember, our Men's Day offering is \$75.00 above your tithes and offerings designated for this effort. Please refer to the chart below.

We are preparing for the Mass Choir Anniversary Concert, which will be held on the Sunday, December 8<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 P.M. This promises to be another fantastic experience. Please support this effort and enjoy the hard work that our choir has put into this fantastic evening.

The calendar has a schedule of events and services that are planned to honor God, our church family, and the dedication of the many individual Christians who are committed to the Lord. Please refer to your newsletter and the calendar of activities and programs that I know that you will enjoy. Listed below is our yearly Plan of Giving that will occur on each of the four Annual Days. Again, our gifts will follow this format:

The total contributions based on this formula, which again, is beyond your normal tithes and offerings is only \$350.00 if you are a single person or if you are a husband and wife family, \$600.00. Additionally, this plan of giving will offer **\$35,000.00 + per year**, above our tithes and offerings, based upon the commitment of 100 members of the Southern Star Family. If we pull together, not waiting for someone else to "do it", we will be able to complete many projects that are needed at our church. We can do this in Jesus' name, not just the present, but for years to come. Again, the success of this effort is twofold: one is obviously needed to finance some of the projects, which are needed at the church, and the second, and most important, is the spiritual component. We must bring all of the tithes and *offerings* to the storehouse so that there may be meat in My house (Malachi 3:10). Additionally, the success of this project is based on the entire church pulling in one, unified direction. I am convinced that the Lord will bless us for our efforts.

## The Star Café - Recipe of the Month

#### Turkey Tetrazzini

2 (8 ounce) packages angel hair pasta	<sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub> teaspoon poultry seasoning
<sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> cup butter	<sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> teaspoon ground mustard
2/3 cup sliced onion	1 cup shredded sharp Cheddar cheese, divided
<sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> cup all-purpose flour	2 tablespoons chopped pimento peppers (optional)
2 cups milk	1 (4.5 ounce) can sliced mushrooms
1 teaspoon salt	1 pound cooked turkey, sliced
<sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> teaspoon ground white pepper	-

- 1. Preheat the oven to 400 degrees F (200 degrees C). Bring a large pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Add the pasta and cook for 4 minutes, or until almost tender. Drain.
- 2. Melt the butter in a saucepan over medium heat. Add the onion; cook and stir until tender. Stir in the flour until blended, then gradually stir in the milk so that no lumps form. Season with salt, pepper, poultry seasoning and mustard. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly until the mixture thickens. Remove from the heat and add 2/3 cup cheese and pimento, stirring until cheese melts. Add undrained mushrooms to cheese sauce.
- 3. Place a layer of pasta in the bottom of a 9x13 inch baking dish. Cover with a layer of turkey, and then a layer of cheese sauce. Repeat the layers. Sprinkle remaining 1/3 cup cheese over top.
- 4. Bake for about 25 minutes in the preheated oven, until sauce is bubbly and cheese on top is toasted.


